COMPETITION CONDITIONS

1. Entrance fees must be paid at time of entry, otherwise they may be rejected. Refunds will not be made for cancellations after the closing date. Entries will not be accepted by telephone. The Executive Committee reserves the right to ballot the field of the Men's Championship if necessary.
2. Events are open to male amateurs who are a member of a Club affiliated with the Geelong District Golf Association, or are a member of The Sands Golf Club. The Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person or team without being requested to give any reason for such refusal.
3. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as are adopted by the R & A Rules Limited, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute should arise on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. Provided, however, that the Committee, if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the Council of the Victorian Golf Association, whose decision shall then be final.
4. The V.G.A. Trophy is open to competitors who are Members of Clubs affiliated with the Geelong District Golf Association or are a member of The Sands Golf Club and whose handicap is 10 strokes or more. (A player once having won the V.G.A. Trophy is debarred from winning on a second occasion.)
5. The winners of the Geelong District Golf Association Championship, the Senior Championship, the V.G.A. Trophy, or the 36 holes Handicap Trophy will not be eligible for any other trophy on that day. Limit one major trophy during any one event.
6. Ties will be decided by count back in all events except G.D.G.A. Championship; which the winner will be decided by play-off as decided by the Executive Committee.
7. The Committee has the power to temporarily alter a player's Australian Handicap in accordance with the Australian Course Rating and Handicapping System.
8. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason, either cancel or shorten the event or fix another day.
9. The committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries which are received for any event and to alter the time fixed for starting any event, as indicated in this programme.
10. Men's Handicap Events maximum handicap 36.
11. DRESS: Dress Regulations on the course and in the clubhouse will be that ruling at each of the participating Clubs on the day of play.
12. The use of motorized transport (motor bikes, golf carts) by a competitor is not permitted unless a medical certificate is provided and permission obtained from the host club.
13. In event 6, preference will be given to players who enter other events during Golf Week. Hit off times between 7.20 and 1p.m.
14. The GDGA has adopted the VGA Code of Conduct for all District Events and this in part requires trophy winners to be in attendance for presentations.
15. Distance measuring devices that show distance (not gradient and wind) are allowed.
16. All draws will be on www.geelongdga.com from 5pm on Tuesday, 12 May 2009.
