Event Outline

- ◆ The Curlewis Par 3 Extravaganza will be played as a stroke event over 18 holes, for a maximum of 120 amateur players.
- ◆ Play will commence via a multi tee start at 12:30pm.
- ◆ Handicap Limit:- 36 (Men), 45 (Women)
- ◆ Entrance Fee (Includes Light Meal):-
 - \$20.00 (Members) - Per Player
 - \$27.50 (Non Members) – Per Player
- ◆ Longest Drive Competitions, Nearest to Pins, In the Circles, Hit the Target, Putting Competitions and Most Accurate Drive will be played as novelty events throughout the event.
- ◆ Entries Close at 5.00pm on Friday 21st May, 2010 or when capacity field is reached.

2010 KWIK KOPY PAR 3 EXTRAVAGANZA - CONDITIONS



1. THE CURLEWIS PAR 3 EXTRAVAGANZA

- 1.1 Eligible players are male and female amateurs whose Australian Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 36 strokes (Male) 45 strokes (Female) and in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
- 1.2 The 2010 Curlewis Par 3 Extravaganza event is scheduled to be played over 18 holes stroke play, on Sunday 30th May, 2010.
- 1.3 The field for the Event will be limited to 120 amateur players and accepted on an as received basis.
- 1.4 The winning male and female with the lowest stroke score shall be the Curlewis Par 3 Champions and shall receive a trophy. The runners-up shall also receive a trophy.
- 1.5 There will be trophies awarded to the nett winners and runners-up for both men's and ladies in the following categories:-
Men's
- A-Grade (+5 to 12), B Grade (13 to 18), C Grade (19 to 36)
Ladies
- All one Grade (Additional Grades to be included if numbers warrant)
- Note: A minimum of five players will be required for trophies to be awarded for a specific category. The Committee reserves the right to redefine the categories should this situation occur
- 1.6 Additional trophies will be awarded as follows:
- Nearest to Pins for:
4th, 8th, 13th & 17th
- Longest Drive Competitions
- Accurate Drive Competitions
- Closest to Line Competitions
- In the Circle Competitions
- Hit the Target Competitions
- Putting Competitions
- 1.7 All ties shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.

2. EVENT COMMITTEE:

The Event Committee shall consist of representatives of the Curlewis Golf Club and an additional person(s) as may be nominated by the Curlewis Match Committee. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision of the full Event Committee. The Event Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event.

In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Event Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion.

Protests must be made to the Event Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round. The decision of the Event Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament.

3. ENTRIES:

The Event Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal. Entrance fees must be paid at the time of entry. Any entrant may withdraw and have his entrance fee refunded providing that notification is received by the time that entries close. All entries must be accompanied by either a current handicap record verified by the club or GolfLink Number. Entries shall only be made on the official entry form unless otherwise permitted by the Event Committee.

4. RULES:

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition rounds are being played. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Event Committee whose decision shall be final. All players are required to adhere to the Curlewis Code of Conduct for the duration of the competition.

5. DRAW AND STARTING TIME:

A draw will be made by the Event Committee. The Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the tee at the time for any player. However, it is a condition of the competition that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification.

6. HONORARY MEMBERS:

Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Curlewis Golf Course for the day.

7. PRACTICE:

Practice is available at the Curlewis Golf Club prior to the event at the cost of a Green Fee.

8. MOTORISED TRANSPORT:

During play, it is prohibited for a player or his caddie to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Championship Committee. Penalty: deduction penalty two strokes at the first hole.

Procedure when breach discovered: Use of any unauthorised form or transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player is disqualified.

9. PACE OF PLAY:

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

10. DRESS STANDARDS:

Players and caddies must observe the dress standards of Curlewis Golf Club.

11. DATABASE OF COMPETITOR'S DETAILS:

- 11.1 The data contained on an entry form submitted by an entrant for Curlewis Golf event is permanently retained by the Club within its database of competitor's details.
- 11.2 This database is operated to assist with the management of current and future Curlewis events.
- 11.3 From time to time players may be sent entry forms or event literature for Curlewis events, and accompanying material.
- 11.4 Upon receipt by the Curlewis Golf Club of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
